
There can be no climate justice without social justice

Where we are with the European Union regulatory proposal


Fairtrade Recommendation	Status
Credible impact assessment on smallholders of regulation	Not yet and no dialogue
Tackle the root causes of deforestation	In trilogue : purchasing practises, fair prices and living income
Safeguards to avoid cut and run	In trilogue : undertake reasonable, documented efforts to support the compliance of smallholders
Support smallholders with compliance and data ownership	In trilogue : minimise burden to smallholders. Purchasers provide timely technical and financial support. Ownership.
Be clear on partnerships and cooperation mechanisms	In trilogue : Proposed strong partnership agreements with special interests of smallholders and local communities

Coops have access to satellite deforestation risk monitoring data


