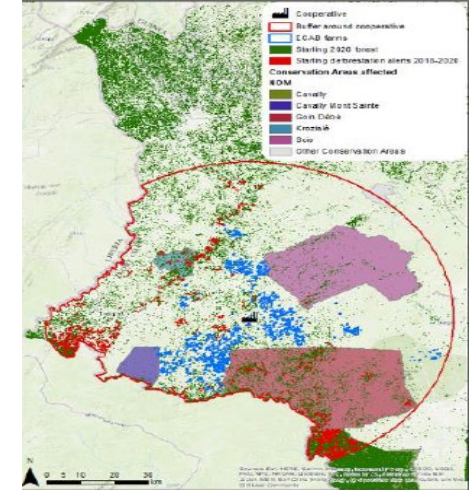
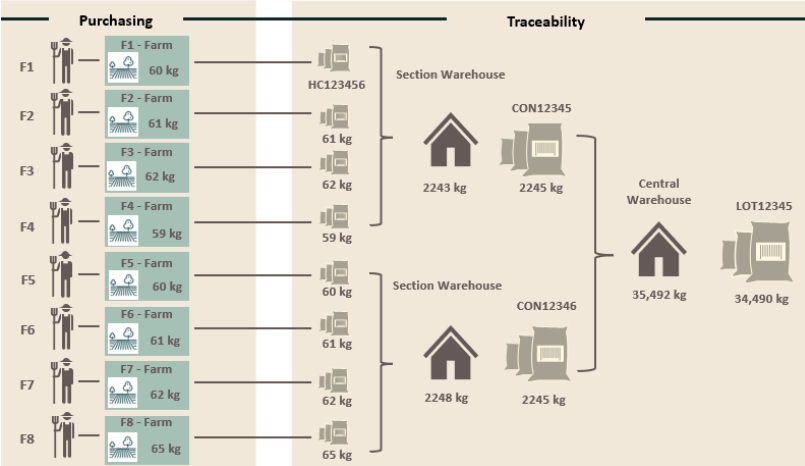
There can be no climate justice without social justice

Fairtrade Recommendation		Status
Credible impact assessment on smallholders of regulation		Not yet and no dialogue
Tackle the root causes of deforestation		<i>In trilogue : purchasing practises, fair prices and living income</i>
Safeguards to avoid cut and run		<i>In trilogue : undertake reasonable, documented efforts to support the compliance of smallholders</i>
Support smallholders with compliance and data ownership		<i>In trilogue : minimise burden to smallholders. Purchasers provide timely technical and financial support. Ownership.</i>
Be clear on partnerships and cooperation mechanisms		<i>In trilogue : Proposed strong partnership agreements with special interests of smallholders and local communities</i>

85% of farmers earn below the living income

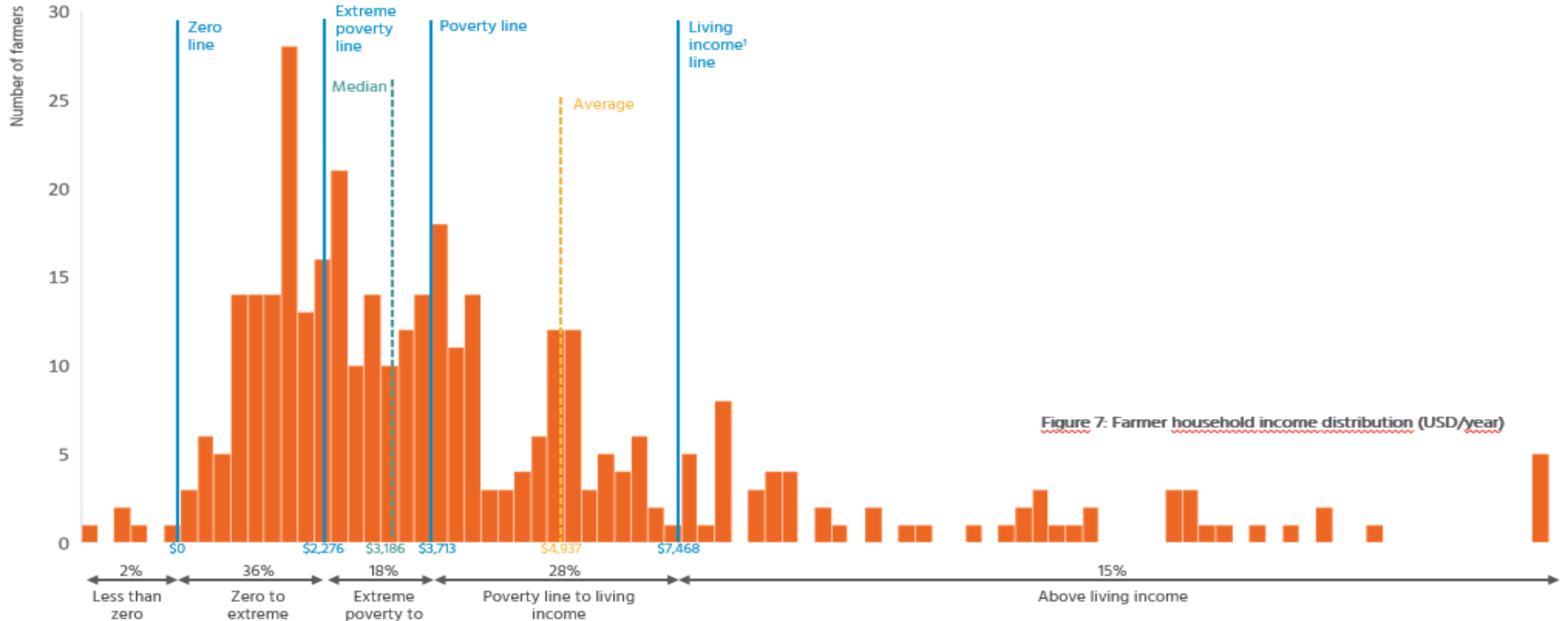


Figure 7: Farmer household income distribution (USD/year)
